IWB Conference

Waverley College hosted the Sixth National Interactive Whiteboard Conference (IWB) last week from Thursday 20 – Saturday 22 August. The Conference theme was “Pushing the Boundaries with your IWB.” The focus of the conference was to challenge and encourage teachers to push boundaries in the use of interactive whiteboards within the classroom. The conference held over 150 workshops catering for beginners to experienced users of interactive whiteboards; primary and secondary teachers and school leaders. The teaching staff across Year 5 – 12 attended a variety of workshops, including hands-on sessions in the computer labs exploring how to use the interactive whiteboard, associated software and related technology to enrich their teaching.

The conference began on Thursday afternoon with boys taking the participants on a guided tour of both the Senior and Junior campus of the College. Many visiting teachers commented on the way the boys acted as tour guides and were ready to highlight the advantages of attending Waverley.

Also on Thursday the latest addition of the 'Activclassroom' was trialed with a group of students in Year 11. This trial attracted media attention from Channel 9 and a number of newspapers. The trial resulted in Peter Harvey from Channel 9 witnessing the classroom in action and interviewing a number of Year 11 students on their thoughts and reactions to this new technology. The boys involved in the trial were certainly ambassadors for the College and learnt a great deal from their involvement with the ongoing evolution of new technology to enhance student learning within the school environment.
